Look at 2014-18 Fishery Report from the DNR regarding chemicals.

Joles commented the DNR have approved a permit for the treatment.

People would like assessment to include everyone using Fife Lake and not just lake front property owners.

Act 188-Statute is not a General Township issue.

Green Lake just dealt with this and may have some recommendations.

Springfield Township-Bonnie Gonyer **Motioned** to Adjourn, Ingersoll Seconded. All in Favor, **Motion Carried.**
