2. Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
3. Roll Call: Sorrow, Allen, Radtke, Zimmerman, Werner, all present.

5. Approval of the agenda:

Sorrow made a motion to approve the agenda with the change of time from 6PM to 5PM and 7.a. is supposed to be assessor instead of auditor. Allen seconded. No discussion. Motion carried unanimously, voice vote.

 - a. Assessor discussion: No candidates available for this meeting.
 - b. NC Dirtworks quote: The bid to fill in around the asphalt driveway of the Fife Lake township and seed along Mogan st. was reviewed and discussed.

c. Savin Milfoil Treatment June 11: Committee met and agreed to move forward with their suggestion to treat on June 11. Cost will be \$18,000-\$20,000.

Radtke made a motion to approve treating the lake on June 11. Zimmerman seconded.
